## Conference Overview

Taking place just before PMA and in the same location, the inaugural International Symposium on Technologies for Digital Fulfillment offers a unique opportunity for technical professionals to meet and to discuss the advances, synergy, and directions of creating, printing, sharing and keeping consumer and professional photos.

The conference will address all aspects associated with generating consumer and professional photos—from capture devices such as camera phones, digital still cameras, and conventional color negative film to image processing and various modes and methods of output.

All types of output media and equipment will be included.

## Proposed Program Topics

Technical paper submissions in the following areas are encouraged:

- Retail fulfillment such as kiosks or minilabs
- Home fulfillment such as snapshot printers
- Mobile fulfillment such as cell phone cameras or on-line photofinishing
- Output Media (AgX, Thermal, EP and Ink Jet)
- Capture Devices (DSCs, Film, Camera Phones)
- Output Equipment (Printers, Minilabs, Kiosks)
- Image processing (Workflow, algorithms)

## Submission Procedures

Prospective authors are invited to submit original papers for presentation in any of the listed technical areas. To ensure that the conference provides significant and timely information to its participants, all submitted papers will be refereed by the technical committee. Papers should be authoritative and complete in regard to advancing the state of knowledge in the subject matter. The conference language will be English.

While use of the Web-based submission process is recommended, submission may also be made via e-mail to [tdf@imaging.org](mailto:tdf@imaging.org). Please put your last name and "TDF 2007 Submission" in the subject line.

### Submissions must include:

- a 200-word abstract clearly identifying the technical content of the paper and (if necessary) what is new compared to previously presented or published material on the same topic
- a 75-word biographical sketch of the primary author
- mailing address, phone, fax, and e-mail for the primary author
- preferred format: oral, interactive, or either

### The deadline for submission is November 1, 2006.

Upon notice of acceptance, authors will be sent detailed instruction for submitting the full text of the paper for publication in the conference proceedings, which will be distributed to each attendee at the meeting. A "transfer of copyright" form must be completed prior to publication. Please note that each author is responsible for obtaining appropriate clearances as necessary for presentation and publication of the work. Papers will be due by January 5, 2007.

The Society for Imaging Science and Technology (IS&T) is an international non-profit whose goal is to keep members aware of the latest scientific and technological developments in the field of imaging through conferences and publications.
