PROPOSED PROGRAM TOPICS

Technical paper submissions in the following areas are encouraged:

- Retail fulfillment such as kiosks or minilabs
- Home fulfillment such as snapshot printers
- Online fulfillment, sharing, and storage
- Mobile fulfillment such as cell phone cameras or on-line photofinishing
- Output Media (AgX, Thermal, EP and Ink Jet)
- Capture Devices (DSCs, Film, Camera Phones)
- Output Equipment (Printers, Minilabs, Kiosks)
- Image processing (Workflow, Algorithms)

SUBMISSION PROCEDURES

Prospective authors are invited to submit original papers for presentation in any of the listed technical areas. To ensure that the conference provides significant and timely information to its participants, all submitted papers will be reviewed by the technical committee. Papers should be authoritative and complete in regard to advancing the state of knowledge in the subject matter. The conference language is English.

Those wishing to submit papers will find details on the submissions process at www.imaging.org/conferences/tdpf2009. While use of the Web-based submission process is recommended, submission may also be sent via e-mail to tdpf@imaging.org. Please put your last name and "TDPF 2009 Submission" in the subject line.

Submissions must include:

- an abstract of up to one page in length clearly identifying the technical content of the paper and (if necessary) what is new compared to previously presented or published material on the same topic
- a 75-word biographical sketch of the primary author
- mailing address, phone, fax, and e-mail for the primary author
- preferred format: oral, interactive, or either

The deadline for abstract submission is August 17, 2008.

Upon notice of acceptance, authors will be sent detailed instruction for submitting the final paper for publication in the conference proceedings (distributed to each attendee at the meeting). A "transfer of copyright" form must be completed prior to publication. Please note that each author is responsible for obtaining appropriate clearances as necessary for presentation and publication of the work.
The deadline for full papers is December 15, 2008.
