CONFERENCE OVERVIEW

The third International Symposium on Technologies for Digital Photo Fulfillment offers a unique opportunity for technical professionals and lab/store owners to meet and discuss the advances, synergies, and future directions of creating, printing, sharing, displaying, and archiving consumer and professional photos and photo-related products. The conference addresses all aspects of generating consumer and professional photos—from capture devices such as camera phones, digital still and HD video devices, and conventional color negative film to photographic image processing, sharing, archiving, and various modes and methods of output. All types of output media and equipment are included.

This year TDPF is held as part of the DIMA Educational Program (collocated with both the Consumer Electronics Show—CES and the Photo Marketing Association Show—PMA), thereby enabling attendees the opportunity to participate in multiple meetings at one time.

PROPOSED PROGRAM TOPICS

Technical paper submissions in the following areas are encouraged:

- Retail fulfillment such as kiosks, minilabs and any other material that can accept an image
- Home, office, retail, commercial fulfillment from snapshot printers to 3D
- Online fulfillment, sharing, and storage
- Mobile fulfillment such as cell phone cameras to on-line photofinishing
- Output media (AgX, thermal, EP, and ink jet)
- Capture devices (DSCs, film, camera phones, HD video devices)
- Output equipment (wet and dry printers and minilabs, processors, kiosks)
- Image processing (workflow, algorithms)

Prospective authors are invited to submit abstracts of original papers for presentation in any of the listed technical areas. To ensure that the conference provides significant and timely information to participants, all submitted abstracts will be reviewed by the program committee. Paper contents should be authoritative and complete in regard to advancing the state of knowledge in the subject matter. The conference language is English. Authors whose abstracts are accepted for presentation are expected to submit final full-paper manuscripts for inclusion in the Symposium Proceedings.

The deadline for abstract submission is October 1, 2011, but we encourage you to get your papers in sooner. There will be a rolling acceptance for this conference.

Upon notice of acceptance, authors will be sent detailed instruction for submitting the final paper for publication in the symposium proceedings. A "transfer of copyright" form must be completed prior to publication. Please note that each author is responsible for obtaining appropriate clearances as necessary for presentation and publication of the work.

The deadline for full papers is November 15, 2011. No extensions will be given.
