The Society for Imaging Science and Technology (IS&T), publisher of the *Journal of Imaging Science and Technology* (JIST), is seeking candidates for the position of JIST Editor.

IS&T is looking for a recognized leader in the field of imaging science who has a broad perspective of the industry, extensive technical knowledge, a strong publication record, and experience serving in an editorial capacity for a peer-reviewed, scholarly journal. The responsibilities of the editor include choosing associate editors, assigning incoming manuscripts to associate editors, overseeing the review process, developing special sections, and undertaking other initiatives to enhance the quality and impact of the journal. The editor is expected to be forward looking, and to provide the stewardship necessary to ensure that JIST is of the highest scientific impact and relevance to the imaging community.

The current editor, Dr. Mel Sahyun, will complete his term in December 2011. The initial appointment for the new editor is a three-year term for the calendar years 2012-2014, and is renewable to a maximum term of ten years. The incoming and outgoing editors will work together during calendar year 2011 to ensure a smooth transition.
